NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY (NOA) ISSUED TO THE TULE BASIN WATER QUALITY COALITION (COALITION) TO SERVE AS THE THIRD-PARTY UNDER GENERAL ORDER R5-2013-0120

On 17 October 2013, the Tule Basin Water Quality Coalition (Coalition) submitted an application to serve as the third-party entity to represent owners and operators of irrigated lands located within the Coalition boundary subject to Waste Discharge Requirements General Order R5-2013-0120 for Growers within the Tulare Lake Basin Area that are Members of a Third-Party Group (General Order). Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board staff (Staff) reviewed the application and concluded that the proposed boundary of the Coalitions coverage area was insufficient and that modifications were needed prior to the approval of the Coalitions application. On 13 December 2013, Staff met with you to discuss the boundary issues and propose a more inclusive alternative boundary.

On 22 January 2014, you submitted an addendum to your October 2013 application that provides an opportunity for all owners and/or operators of irrigated lands to fulfill their regulatory obligations through membership in a third-party group by allowing parcels outside the Coalitions boundary (see supplemental coverage area in enclosed Figure 1, Boundary Map) to enroll in the Coalition.

Based on staff review of your application and your record of representing growers under the Conditional Waiver, your Coalition meets the requirements of the General Order to serve as a third-party entity, provided that all enrolled irrigated agricultural lands within the boundaries identified in Figure 1 are considered by the third-party when meeting the requirements of the General Order.



FIGURE 1, MAP OF THE TULE BASIN WATER QUALITY COALITION BOUNDARY

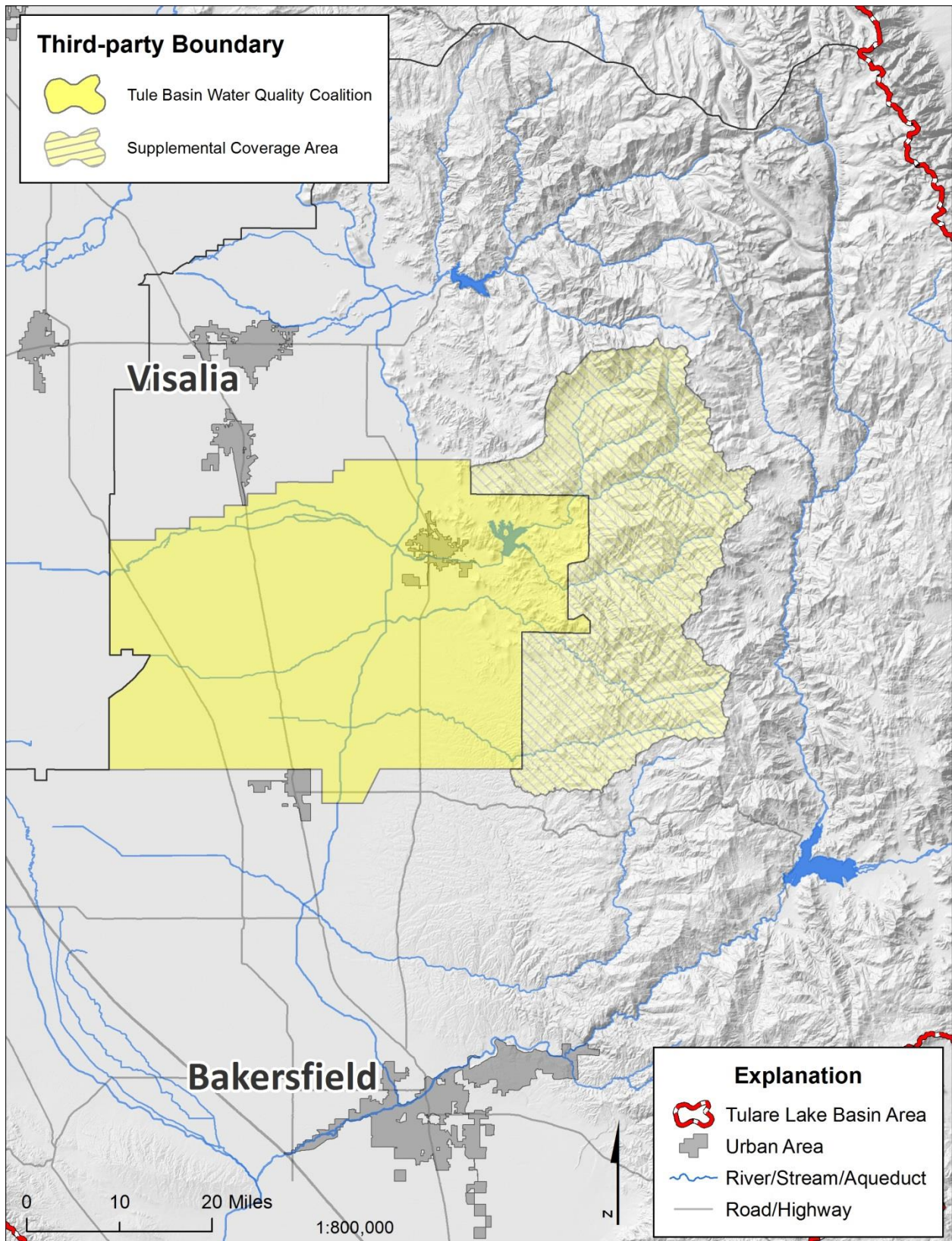
