The Key Elements of Grower Requirements and deadlines for upholding compliance under the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP) are provided as follows:

Check Box	Item	Due Date	Notes		
	Pay Annual Dues	To be paid by June 30th - Annually	Annual Renewal Period: May 1st to June 30th Members are to provide up-to-date information of irrigated lands to the Coalition during renewal period, and pay annual membership dues.		
	Attend 1 Outreach Event	Attend by June 30th - Annually	Attend a meeting held by the TBWQC or any Coalition in the Central Valley. Log in to the TBWQC website for upcoming events. You may also view TBWQC meeting videos online.		
	Obtain copy of General Order	Obtain as soon as possible - One Time	The General Order must be kept at farm office, as either a hard copy or digital form. Please contact the Coalition and we will provide a CD of the General Order. Members may download a copy from the TBWQC website.		
	Farm Evaluation (FE)	Complete & Submit by March 1st - Annually	The FE template is based on the previous year crop. Members are to provide up-to-date information of farming practices annually. Updates can be submitted by returning the mailed/emailed copy, or update online. An instructional video is available on TBWQC website. <i>Example: 2016 crop year, submittal deadline March 1, 2017.</i>		
	Nitrogen Management Plan (NMP)	Complete by March 1st - Annually	Growers are required to complete the NMP for the upcoming crop year. All reports must be certified. If members would like to become self-certified, class information is available on our website. <i>Please keep completed NMP Plan at farm office. Do not submit to the TBWQC.</i>		
	Nitrogen Management Plan (NMP) Summary Report	Complete & submit by March 1st - Annually	NMP Summary Report is to be submitted to the Coalition annually, based on the previously completed NMP Plan (See Above).

	Sediment & Erosion Control Plan	October 26th 2016	<i>Not required by all members.</i> Landowners who have high potential for Sediment and Erosion, as determined by the Regional Water Quality Control Board, and contacted by the Coalition.
