

Should I be enrolled in the Irrigated Lands Regulatory program?

Growers must have all the following:

- Irrigated Lands
- Land Used for Commercial Purposes

No, this does not apply to me.

If you have received a letter from the Regional Board, please inform them that you either do not have irrigated ag or your small irrigated ag is only for personal use.

No other Action Required

YES, both apply to me.
See what option best fits your situation.

Option 1:
Sign up with the Coalition as a Third-Party Representative

Coalition provides customer service to ensure members are aware and complying to requirements set by the General Order of the ILRP

Joining the Coalition is Voluntary

If you would like to enroll in the Coalition, please call our office at 559.733.2948

New 2020-2021 Membership Year fees are as follows:

- \$4.00 per Irrigated acre
- \$0.00 per fallow or non-irrigated acres
- \$100 Participation Fee

Each year, landowners can adjust and update irrigated acres to reflect your farming practice for future year.

Option 2:
Apply for an individual Waste Discharge Permit

Find the link for the Individual Waste Discharge application above to get enrolled.

Option 3:
Already complying under a General Order as such:

- Dairy General Order
- Feedlot General Order
- Food Processor General Order

You may fall under the terms of the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program but are already complying under a different General Order.
****Growers do not have to enroll in multiple programs****

****Example****

If you also have a dairy facility and complying with the Dairy General Order, you may either:

1. Keep all property enrolled in the Dairy General Order and follow those guidelines.
2. You can comply under both and take out the Irrigated Lands property from the Dairy General order and enroll in the Irrigated Lands Regulatory General Order.

Option 4:
Do nothing - Non-Compliance (Not Recommended)

Failure to obtain regulatory coverage will result in the Central Valley Water Board assessing an administrative civil liability against

Administrative civil liability can run as high as \$1,000 per day for every day of violation. Our staff is available to assist you in obtaining the proper regulatory coverage.
